Rational for career choices	When I was 11 years old, I thought that the Arms Race was fundamentally wrong. I reasoned that it was not God but mankind who was misguided, and that if one searched hard enough in nature, one would find the counter-balancing "good" (to nuclear weapons). I therefore decided to study physics.
